Structure, governance and management

Type of governing document

Innerleithen Pipe Band is an unincorporated association governed by a constitution adopted by the Band in 2002.

The Band is governed by a management committee elected annually from its membership by the Band's AGM.

The Band is led musically by a Pipe Major, Leading Drummer and a Drum Major who are elected annually from its membership by the Band's AGM.

Trustee recruitment and appointment

Trustees are elected annually for a period of 1 year by the Band's AGM, Any member of the Band is eligible to stand for election. Trustees resign at each AGM but are eligible for immediate re-election.

Objectives and activities

Charitable purposes

The objects of the band shall be to advance the education of the public in the art of Bagpipe Playing and Drumming by the presentation of public performances and other related activities. In furtherance thereof but not otherwise the band shall seek:

- a) To promote pipe bands and the playing of pipe band music
- b) To form and maintain a competition pipe band
- c) To compete at the highest possible grade in competition
- To maintain membership of the Royal Scottish Pipe Band Association or its successor organisation
- e) To provide tuition and education in the playing of bagpipes and drums
- f) To do all other things as are charitable in law for the attainment of these
- The Band held regular twice weekly practices throughout the year.
- The Band has been providing tuition to several learners at various stages of development on chanter, bagpipe, stick & pad and drums.
- The Band played at 29 engagements over the year.
- The Band managed to participate in four local pipe band competition during 2019, and three major Pipe Band Championships.

Summary of the main activities in relation to these objects

Achievements and performance

Summary of the main achievements of the charity during the financial period

- The Band continued its membership of the Royal Scottish Pipe Band Association (RSPBA).
- The Band continued to develop its playing personnel by providing tuition in the arts of bagpiping and drumming at twice weekly practices.
- The Band was upgraded by the RSPBA to Grade 3B, a higher level of ability, for the 2019 contest season.
- The Band played in three of the five major pipe band championships held in 2019 at its new Grade 3B level.
- The Band appeared at four pipe band competitions during the year, at Dunbar, North Berwick, Peebles and Innerleithen. Prizes were picked up by the Band at Peebles and Innerleithen.
- The Band continued to develop its playing repertoire for the enjoyment of playing members and listening public.
- The Band continued to enjoy success in obtaining grants to fund its ongoing work.
- The Band made good use of its refurbished Band Hall weekly practices were held in the hall, and the hall was hired out to other organisations thus generating income. The hall was equipped with new tables and chairs.

Financial review

Brief statement of the charity's policy on reserves

The Band's constitution states that the Band must hold a minimum of £50 in its bank accounts. As at 31/12/2019 the band held general reserves of £7617.86. The band holds reserves in order to enable it to meet on-going running costs and asset purchases to enable it to continue with its activities.

The band has a designated fund for the purpose of refurbishing the Band Hall, sited in Hall Street Innerleithen. As at 31/12/2019 the fund held £3048.55. Some equipment replenishment was undertaken in 2019.

Details of any deficit

There was no deficit in 2019.

Donated facilities and services (if any)

The Band is composed entirely of volunteers who donate their time freely to attend practices, playing engagements and competitions. Band members also volunteer to administer the band.

The Band has donated to it by the Vale of Leithen Social Club the use of the Club's function hall for practice purposes which the committee estimate is worth approximately £1000 pa to the Band.
