## Structure, governance and management

#### Type of governing document

Innerleithen Pipe Band is an unincorporated association governed by a constitution adopted by the Band in 2002.

The Band is governed by a management committee elected annually from its membership by the Band's AGM.

The Band is led musically by a Pipe Major, Leading Drummer and a Drum Major who are elected annually from its membership by the Band's AGM

#### Trustee recruitment and appointment

Trustees are elected annually for a period of 1 year by the Band's AGM. Any member of the Band is eligible to stand for election. Trustees resign at each AGM but are eligible for immediate re-election.

## Objectives and activities

### Charitable purposes

The objects of the band shall be to advance the education of the public in the art of Bagpipe Playing and Drumming by the presentation of public performances and other related activities. In furtherance thereof but not otherwise the band shall seek:

- To promote pipe bands and the playing of pipe band music.
- To form and maintain a competition pipe band.
- To compete at the highest possible grade in competition.
- d) To maintain membership of the Royal Scottish Pipe Band Association or its successor organisation.
- To provide tuition and education in the playing of bagpipes and drums.
- f) To do all other things as are charitable in law for the attainment of these objects

#### Summary of the main activities in relation to these objects

- The Band held regular weekly practices throughout 2024.
- The Band attended twenty-six playing engagements during 2024.
- The Band attended EIGHT pipe band competitions during 2024 and won prizes at seven of them.

## Achievements and performance

Summary of the main achievements of the charity during the financial period

- The Band continued its membership of the Royal Scottish Pipe Band Association (RSPBA).
- The Band held several in-person fundraising events throughout the year.
- The Band participated in twenty-six playing engagements throughout the year.
- The Band participated in eight pipe band competitions throughout the year.
- The Band won prizes at seven of the eight competitions attended.
- The Band was crowned Scottish Champions in Grade 4A in 2024.
- The Band won Champion of Champions titles for band and drum corps - in Grade 4A in 2024.
- The Band was promoted from Grade 4A to Grade 3B at the end of the 2024 pipe band contest season.
- The Band commenced preparation for the 2025 pipe band competition season.

### Financial review

Brief statement of the charity's policy on reserves The Band's constitution states that the Band must hold a minimum of £50 in its bank accounts. As at 31/12/2024 the band held general unrestricted reserves of £8113.31.

The band holds reserves to enable it to meet on-going running costs and asset purchases to enable it to continue with its activities.

The band has a designated fund for the purpose of refurbishing and maintaining the Band Hall, sited in Hall Street Innerleithen. As at 31/12/2024 the fund held £804.61.

Details of any deficit

The deficit of £95.80 was due to expenditure exceeding income – whilst income from certain sources was up from 2023 levels e.g. prize money won at contests, due to good band performances, expenditure was also up mainly due to increased utilities costs. Steps are being taken to reduce these in 2025.
